On 7 July 1846, the American Commodore Sloat declared California belonged to Mexico territory of the United States. Republic Bear Flag as Mexico and the United States shared California Territorial disputes between the United States and Spain began in 1817 when the us army invaded Spanish Florida under the pretext of protecting their southern territories from the Indians. The result was a Treaty of territorial delimitation in North America signed February 22, 1819, U.S. Secretary of state John Adams and foreign Minister of Spain Luis de Unisom. The document enshrines for Mexico the territory of Upper California, new Mexico and Texas entered into force in exactly two years, six months before independence. These lands were little inhabited and attracted settlers from the United States. For Mexicans, the task of development was difficult because much of the male population died during the war for independence and the country's economy was in decline. Besides the military system of Mexico could not provide security for potential settlers nor the preservation of the territorial integrity of the country. The first attempt to seize territory previously ceded to Mexico the us government has made at the end of 1821. The project for inclusion in the composition of the States of Texas, New Mexico, Upper California and parts of Baja California was proposed by the Mexican authorities as conditions for the recognition of the independence of the former Spanish colony. Mexican Emperor Agustin I did not agree but passed a law allowing Americans to freely settle in any part of the country. In 1826 the law on free colonization was modified and now in Texas would only allow Mexican immigrants. In 1828, the U.S. government entered into with Mexico the Treaty confirms the established in 1819 the border but did not leave hopes to buy California and Texas. The administrations of presidents John Adams, Andrew Jackson and then John Tyler unsuccessfully increased the money supply over the territory, or at least part of the California coast. Meanwhile, the threat to the territorial integrity of Mexico was brewing within the country, the lawlessness and dictatorship have pushed Texas and Yucatan Express a desire to secede that they had a constitutional right. In early March 1836, the Texas house of representatives declared the independence of Texas on may 14 signed a contract and the end of the year after the adoption of the Constitution of Texas announced
