

Texas anti-abortion

The Senate of Texas on the third attempt voted for the controversial law banning abortion after 20 weeks of pregnancy. The bill also toughens the conditions of registration in the state clinics providing abortion forcing most of them to close. The Republican majority in the Senate was ready to pass a law in late June, but democratic Senator Wendy Davis managed to disrupt the vote continuously speaking for nearly 11 hours, a tactic known in the American parliamentary traditions like the filibuster. After that, despite the mobilization of activists for the right to abortion Texas Governor Rick Perry who promised to sign the law convened a special meeting of the chamber. Before the new vote in the Senate to the state capital Austin in large numbers flocked by both supporters and opponents of abortion. The constitutional right of women to abortion was established in US in 1973 precedent the Supreme court's decision in ROE V. Wade. However, in recent years a number of conservative States passed laws severely restricting access to the Texas procedure in this case follows the example of Mississippi Ohio Oklahoma Alabama Kansas Wisconsin and Arizona. Restrictions for clinics practicing abortions found that in such institutions should be the conditions for surgical procedures and all the doctors doing the abortion should also be authorized for hospitalization of patients in a hospital located at a distance of not more than 30 miles 48 km from the clinic. Newspaper Texas Tribune estimated that in Texas there are only six clinics meet these requirements. Click here to cancel reply.
